# Maruti Suzuki (MSIL IN)

Rating: HOLD | CMP: Rs16,155 | TP: Rs16,215

## Strong realization, post GST 2.0 volume spurt

## **Quick Pointers:**

- Expects to surpass its FY26 exports volume target of 400k units (H1FY26 exports at 207k units)
- 8 new SUVs (excl. Victoris) to be launched by FY31

MSIL reported mixed numbers with operating revenue surging due to betterthan-expected realization, but profitability missing estimates due to higher commodity & promotions costs (which we expect to continue along with margin pressure from EVs) and lower non-operating income. However, improved mix from new launches and better scale should partially offset the drag on margins ahead. The management expects overall industry to grow by 6% and its small cars (18% GST bracket) to grow by ~10% in H2FY26 & beyond. Post-festive sustenance of demand and response to new launches & related cannibalization are to be watched out for. We marginally tweak volume, realization and margin estimates. The stock has run up ~25% since the 1st GST change announcement on 15th Aug'25. We expect its overall volume and blended realization to grow at 7.5% & 9.3% CAGR, respectively, over FY25-28E translating to revenue/EBITDA/EPS CAGR of 17.5%/15.7%/16.1%. Retain "HOLD" rating with TP of Rs16,215 (previous Rs15,764), valuing the stock at 25x P/E on its Sep'27 earnings. The stock currently trades at a P/E of 27.5x/24.4x based on FY27E/FY28E consensus earnings.

Standalone operating revenue grows by 13.2% YoY to Rs421bn, beating BBGe/PLe by 5.4%/3%, led by strong realization (+11.3% YoY, +5.0% QoQ). However, its UV mix declined YoY and sequentially to 36.0% of its domestic PV volume. Gross profit increased by 8.4% YoY, while margin contracted (-120bps YoY, -90bps QoQ) to 26.9%, missing BBGe/PLe by 70bps/100bps. EBITDA margin came in at 10.5% (-130bps YoY, +10bps QoQ), fairly in line with BBGe, but 60bps below PLe. PAT rose by 7.3% YoY due to lower current tax, but missed BBGe/PLe by 7.8%/11.1% due to lower non-operating income YoY. For H1FY26, EBITDA declined by 5.5% YoY while PAT grew by 4.3% YoY.

Adverse commodity costs and Fx offset the cost reduction efforts YoY. Expenses related to promotions, new Kharkhoda plant & staff expenses were also higher, leading to its margin declining 130bps YoY. The 20bps Fx benefit accrued due to hedging gain was accounted for in non-operating income. Hardening of bond yields impacted its investment surplus MTM, dragging non-operating income YoY. Sequentially, favorable factors of leverage (+110bps contribution to margin) and lower operating expenses (+50bps contribution) were partially offset by promotional expenses (-75bps), price correction (-20bps), advertisement expenses largely related to new Victoris (-15bps) and Fx (related to Japanese Yen movement) + commodities (increase in Platinum group metal prices) adversely by 30bps.

Festive season stats for MSIL (22<sup>nd</sup> Sep'25-31<sup>st</sup> Oct'25): Bookings of 500k units (of which ~200k bookings are pending) vs 350k units in the same period last year. Retail sales of 400k units (250k were small cars, which almost doubled, including some deferred sales) vs 211k units last year. Q2FY26 retail sales were 394k units and at the industry level; sedan segment's growth outpaced that of SUVs after a long time. MSIL's Oct'25 retail sales grew by 20% YoY with vehicles in the 18% GST bracket growing by 30%, while those in the 40% bracket rising by 4-5% YoY. The management expects small cars to grow faster but will reassess post Jan'26. We

expect its H2FY26 domestic volume to grow by  $\sim$ 7% YoY boosted by the GST 2.0 led spurt in small cars sales, whereas export volumes to continue their strong run and grow by  $\sim$ 50% YoY with the new e-Vitara ramp-up across the globe.

## Key concall highlights:

- In Q2FY26, MSIL's market share by volume in PV exports was 45.4%, and total exports revenue was Rs83bn driven by the new e-Vitara and Fronx.
- The management aspires to reach an ambitious 10% EBIT margin (was 8.5% in Q2FY26, 8.3% in Q1FY26) and 50% market share in the long term, but acknowledges that it's tough to achieve.
- Depreciation increase was due to the new Kharkhoda plant and Victoris launch.
- ASP was Rs587k in Q2FY26, vs Rs566k in Q2FY25 and Rs576k in Q1FY26.
- Inventory stood at ~38 days at Sep'25-end (will be lower at Oct'25-end, was
   ~30days at Oct'24-end) vs ~33 days in Q1FY26.

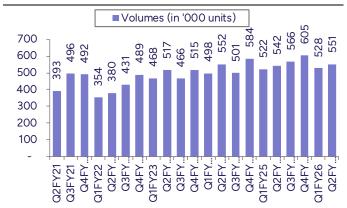

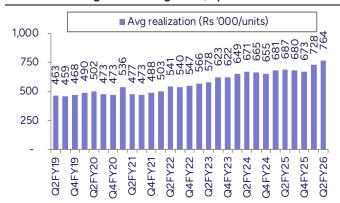

Exhibit 3: UV mix at 36.0% of domestic PV volume in Q2FY26



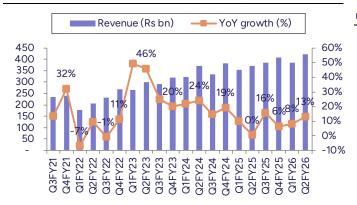

Exhibit 4: Strong realization growth, up 11.3% YoY in Q2FY26



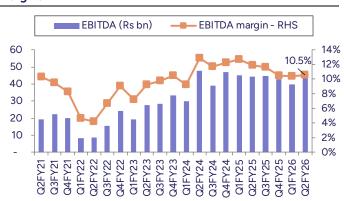
