

# SUMMARY OF MF PERFORMANCE— JANUARY 2019

The performance of Equity Mutual Funds (including ELSS) remained subdued in January 2019, with the broad market indices ending the month in the red. The mid cap and small cap indices too came under pressure in the first month of the calendar year, after posting two consecutive months of gains.

The Nifty 50-TRI closed with loss of -0.24%, while the Nifty Midcap 100-TRI fell 5.42% and the Nifty SmallCap 100-TRI declined 4.88% over the month.

Out of the 200-odd equity diversified funds, 93% of the schemes closed the month with a loss. The 1-year weighted average return of all equity mutual funds worked out to -2.41%, down from 1.21% registered last month.

Many equity schemes were found struggling against the benchmark in the 1-year period. Just 32% or 63 schemes out of 199 open-ended diversified equity funds were able to beat their benchmark over the past year.

The 1-year returns of Systematic Investment Plans (SIPs) of most open-ended equity schemes (including ELSSs) remained in the red. Just 3 schemes were able to generate an absolute return of over 1%. (*The monthly investment was made on the 1st of every month between February 1, 2018 and January 1, 2019. The investments were valued on January 31, 2019.*)

Investors are advised to stick to their SIP investments and keep a long-term focus. SIPs over the past 3-years have yielded a return in excess of 10% for the top quartile equity funds.
















